There are **no second chances** in a fire.

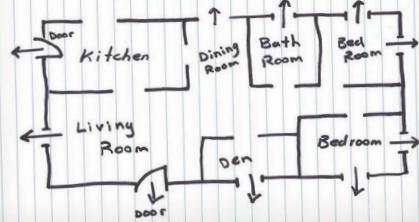
## Follow these simple steps:

Test your smoke alarms—  
**every month!**



Discuss with everyone in your home how each person will get out in a fire.

## Practice your plan!



Know **two ways** out of each room, if possible.



Determine who's going to help  
**young children,**  
**older adults,**  
**people with**  
**disabilities** or  
anyone else  
who needs  
help escaping.





Have a **meeting place** outside your home.

**emergency  
number**  
from outside  
the home.



## GET OUT, STAY OUT!

burning building!



**EVERY SECOND COUNTS!**  
Fire and smoke can travel so quickly that despite their best efforts, firefighters may not be able to rescue you or your family if a fire occurs in your home. You **need** to be *out of your home* when the firefighters arrive!
