About Your Bill

Monthly Fixed Service Charges help pay for maintaining and replacing water and sewer pipes in the City.

On average a water bill is \$224 for two months based on 30 m³, for a residential property.

Not using water?
Water bills are issued for Fixed Service Charges, a minimum of \$118.74, when no water is used.
