The City of Niagara Falls or its agent may access utility billing account information for the purpose of monitoring water and energy consumption;

THAT the City of Niagara Falls does not guarantee or warrant the rain barrel or its installation, the performance, freedom from defects, quality of workmanship or suitability of the rain barrel or any installation thereof for any purpose, or the suitability of the premises for installation. Further, the Applicant acknowledges and agrees to assume any and all costs of the installation or any alterations necessary for the proper installation of the rain barrel;

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Additional Instructions and Program Notes:

- 1. Once completed, all applications must be handed in to Cashiers (Finance Department) at City Hall, or at the customer service centre located at the MacBain Community Centre.
- All applications <u>must</u> be accompanied by a **copy** of the original receipt from a **Canadian** retailer. If the rain barrel Manufacturer, Make, and Model number are not listed on the receipt, a copy of this information as shown on either the Owner's manual or the packaging <u>must</u> be included with the application.
- 3. The City is offering a maximum of one (1) rebate per residence for installing a rain barrel. The rebate is 50% of the cost of the rain barrel, up to a maximum of \$50.
- 4. Rain barrel must be new. Rain barrels are available at most home and garden retailers.
- 5. Rain barrel must be installed at a property located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Niagara Falls.
- 6. **Applications do not guarantee a rebate** as they are evaluated and processed on a first come first serve basis. All rebates are subject to availability of funds and the rebate program may be changed or terminated without notice.
- 7. Rebates will only be credited to the water service account for the address where the rain barrel was installed. Proof of an active water service account at the subject address may be required (ie. a current water bill). Please allow four to six weeks to process.
- 8. Applications will only be received for purchases made within the current calendar year (2019).
- 9. We recommend you make a copy of your completed application form and receipts for your records, as all information provided will not be returned.
- 10. The City of Niagara Falls actively encourages residents to purchase rain barrels at local retailers, however it is not mandatory to do so. The rain barrel must be purchased in Canada.
- 11. IMPORTANT: Collected rainwater is not for human consumption.
- 12. Tip: Pay attention to the weather and when rain is in the forecast, please be encouraged to empty the rain barrel of any unused rain water in the days prior to the rain event. This allows the barrel to re-fill and conserves treated water that would otherwise be used for outdoor irrigation.
