Participants are asked to observe the following safety rules for the enjoyment of all participants:

*****FAILURE TO ABIDE BY RULES MAY RESULT IN PROGRAM CANCELLATION*****

ALL PROGRAMS

- Sign-ins will not be accepted until ½ hour prior to program start time
- Proof of payment (i.e. bracelet) may be required prior to entering ice surface
- Profanity and improper behavior will NOT be permitted
- Report all accidents or injuries to skate patrol or arena staff members immediately
- All participants must wear skates while on the ice surface
- Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, or anyone under the influence will not be permitted on the premises
- No personal or group instruction allowed during any of the public skates

Saturday Public Skating Gale Centre

- No skating aids, chairs, sleds, pylons, hockey sticks, pucks and other obstructions are permitted on the ice surface
- Food and drink are not permitted on the ice surface or players bench.
- No horseplay. Games such as tag or racing, as well as backwards skating, figure skating maneuvers or erratic skating are not permitted
- Refrain from carrying children
- Do not throw ice or snow
- Please skate at a sensible speed, adhere to the directions of skate patrol and/or arena staff members

Saturday Chippawa & Sunday Public Skating Gale Centre

- Skating aids permitted
- Chairs, sleds, pylons, hockey sticks, pucks and other obstructions are not permitted on the ice surface
- No horseplay. Games such as tag or racing, as well as backwards skating, figure skating maneuvers or erratic skating are not permitted

Adult/Senior Skate

- Hockey sticks, pucks & other obstructions are not permitted on the ice
- Please skate at a sensible speed, adhere to the directions of arena staff members

Tiny Tots Skate

- Skating aids are permitted and refrain from carrying children

Pay as You Play Hockey • Full equipment and a light and dark jersey are required

- Slap Shots checking or fighting are not permitted
- First 2 Goalies skate for free

Stick & Puck – *******HELMET MANDATORY FOR YOUTH & ADULT STICK & PUCK SKATES******* (maximum 30 Participants)

- A parent (Adult 18yrs+) is recommended to be on the ice or in the rink with their children & is responsible for supervision
- Slap shots are not permitted during youth stick & puck
- Be mindful of those around you when shooting the puck
- Smaller/beginner skaters at one end and bigger/advanced skaters at the other end
- Organized games or practices are NOT permitted
