ALL PROGRAMS

- Profanity and improper behavior will NOT be permitted
- Report all accidents or injuries to skate patrol or arena staff members immediately
- All participants must wear skates while on the ice surface
- Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, or anyone under the influence will not be permitted on the premises

Sunday Public Skating - Gale Centre

- Skating aids permitted
- Chairs, sleds, pylons, hockey sticks, pucks and other obstructions are not permitted on the ice surface
- No horseplay. Games such as tag or racing, as well as backwards skating, figure skating maneuvers or erratic skating are not permitted

Adult/Senior Skate

- Hockey sticks, pucks & other obstructions are not permitted on the ice
- Please skate at a sensible speed, adhere to the directions of arena staff members

Tiny Tots Skate

- Skating aids are permitted
- Refrain from carrying children

Stick & Puck *HELMET MANDATORY FOR YOUTH & ADULT STICK & PUCK SKATES*****

- A parent (Adult 18yrs+) is required to be on the ice with their children & is responsible to supervise their child
- Slap shots are not permitted
- Be mindful of those around you when shooting the puck
- Smaller/beginner skaters at one end and bigger/advanced skaters at the other end
- Organized games or practices are NOT permitted

Pay as You Play 65+, (groups based on skill level)

- Organized and monitored scrimmage hockey

70+ Pond Hockey & Sr. Stick & Puck

- Pond Hockey (organized and monitored)
- Stick & Puck (no scrimmaging)

Pay as You Play 75+

- Organized and monitored scrimmage hockey
