


CORE ASSETS

The City's total core asset replacement value is approximately \$2.5 billion.

ASSETAGE

Many of the City's core assets still have greater than 60% life left remaining based on the age of the asset.

BUDGET FACTS

Currently the City invests close to \$25 million dollars annually to maintain it's core assets.



The City should be investing closer to **\$32.7** million dollars annually.

Annual infrastructure re-investment GAP of \$7.8 miliion.

The City has an infrastructure backlog of \$58 million.



The backlog is made up of assets that have reached or exceeded their estimated service lives.
