- The Region of Niagara's DEI Advisor presented to the committee.
- Presentation was summary of data collected from community DEI Survey.
- 1599 surveys were completed but only 183 (11%) were from Niagara Falls
- Top 5 areas of discrimination experienced included (Gender, Age, Mental Health, Ethnicity, Ability/Disability).
- Forms of discrimination included (insulting comments, barriers to participation, teasing, mocking, verbal abuse, hate speech, microaggressions)
