# **1. Adoption of Minutes**

#### a) Events Re-cap for 2016

The committee was made aware of the 2016 event/program accomplishments. Highlights included the planting of over 1,000 trees, \$34,500 in grants/donations procured, 19 events held, 112 awards distributed, over 6,000 flowers planted or given away and 1,631 of volunteer service hours completed.

#### b) Event Changes

Staff is waiting on approval to have event fees waived by the Niagara Parks Commission in order to host the Ride of Silence event along the Niagara Parkway.

The September, 2017 committee meeting is changed to September 13. The Summer Trillium Awards are scheduled for Wednesday, September 20.

The January, 2017 committee meeting is changed to January 11.

#### c) Green Burial Project

The City was approved for a \$25,000 CN EcoConnexion grant to help develop a green burial site at Fairview Cemetery. A volunteer tree planting event will take place on Friday, September 29. Staff will make a presentation on the project at the January, 2017 meeting.
