



Volunteer Information

This is a rain or shine event, please dress for the elements. However, in the event of lightning or thunder, volunteers are to stop and take shelter.

Safety is a priority. Please use caution and common sense. DO NOT pick-up possible containments, large objects or needles. Notify City Staff of the location of these objects by emailing rc@niagarafalls.ca at the conclusion of your clean-up.

Stay away from over passes and road ways.

Please wear bright clothing and do not wear any jewelry. Covered toe shoes are required. Consider covering your arms and legs for protection.

DO NOT walk or pick litter on the pavement, shoulder or in the median of a roadway.

DO NOT collect broken glass or other sharp objects in a trash bag. Notify staff of your findings upon your return.

Drink lots of fluids while you work and consider wearing sun screen and a hat if needed.

Stay clear of any construction of water hazards.

Be aware of any special needs of fellow volunteers (eg, Medical conditions).

Stay alert for and avoid hazardous plants and stinging insects.

Volunteers can venture off to an area they feel needs to be cleaned as long as it is City property. Please do not clean private property.

All volunteers are to conclude their clean-up by the end of daylight at the latest.
