REGISTRATION

1. Recruit your team of up to 10 pullers. Your Team cheering section is welcome and encouraged!
2. Choose your Team Captain and a Team Name.
3. Become familiar with the Rules.
4. Advanced registration is encouraged but teams may register the day of the event until 12:30 pm pending space availability. Register early to avoid disappointment.

6. Have each team member sign a waiver and media permission and consent form.

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AWARDS

Awards will be given to the teams with the **Fastest Pull Time**, **Best Team Spirit** and **Highest Team Donation**.

RULES

1. Registration will be open to the first teams who complete and return their registration forms in good order, including remittance of the minimum donation to Niagara Health Foundation of \$250/team.
2. All participants must sign a waiver and media permission and consent form on the day of the event.
3. The fire truck pull will take place rain or shine on Sunday, September 10, at approximately 1:00 pm.
4. Team start times will be assigned by a draw system once registration closes at 12:30 pm.
5. Teams are limited to no more than 10 pullers. Any person without a signed waiver will not be allowed to pull.
6. Recruitment of team member(s) from other teams the day of the event is not permitted. A team member may only pull for one team.
7. Team Captains are responsible for having their team ready, 15 minutes prior to their scheduled pull time.
8. Teams may station their pullers on the rope in any order but may not tie the rope around the anchor puller.
9. Teams may not attach anything to the rope. They may remove slack but not commence pulling until signaled. No jerking of the rope is allowed.
10. The signal to begin the pull from the Referee is... Ready, Set, and the blowing of an air horn.
11. Timing begins at the sound of the horn and continues until the truck is pulled the required 50 feet distance or 5 minutes has elapsed. Elapsed time will be recorded as the team score. Two attempts are allowed and the best time will be recorded. After 5 minutes, if your team has not pulled the Fire Truck across the finish line on either attempt, the team will be disqualified.
12. A referee will signal when the end of the pull and the truck brakes will be applied.
13. Times for the truck pull will be determined by time-keepers operating stop watches. If different times are recorded the average time will be used. The ruling of the referee stands.
14. The top three fastest scores will proceed to the finals to determine the winner.
15. Should there be a tie for the fastest score, there will be a pull-off to determine the ultimate winner.
16. Pull times will be listed on a score board near the Registration area.
17. Gloves are permitted. Closed toe shoes are required, sandals are not permitted.
18. Upon completion of the pull, the team will immediately assemble in front of the fire truck for a team photo, before the truck is returned to the starting line. Teams must then clear the area for safety.
19. Awards ceremony will immediately follow the close of the competition.
20. A group photo of all participants/ teams together will take place at the end of the Fire Truck Pull Event at the front of the fire truck.
21. The decisions of the Referee are final.

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
