POSITION TITLE: Garage Mechanic

POSITION SUMMARY: Perform mechanical repairs to all City equipment.

DIVISION: Operations

SECTION: Equipment - Garage

EQUIPMENT AND TOOLS USED: Mechanics tools, electronic scanners, diagnosing laptop, hoist, boom, torches, testing equipment, power tools.

WORKING CONDITIONS: Fleet garage and outdoors

- RESPONSIBLE FOR:**
1. Performs mechanical and electrical repairs to all City small and large vehicles and equipment. Diagnosing and repairing computerized systems.
 2. Maintain a Mechanic's repair log daily.
 2. Perform safety inspections.
