POSITION TITLE: Senior Manager of Roadways and Parks

POSITION SUMMARY: The Senior Manager of Roadways and Parks assumes lead

accountability and responsibility for the Roadways Section and the planning maintenance and monitoring of all municipal assets

located within the road allowance and parkland under the

jurisdiction of the City of Niagara Falls.

Is accountable for ensuring the established levels of service and/or minimum maintenance standards are adhered to in accordance with City and Provincial regulations, policies, and

guidelines with minimal disruption to the public.

DIVISION / DEPARTMENT: Municipal Works / Operations (Roadways, Construction, Parks,

Forestry)

RESPONSIBLE TO: Director of Operations, Municipal Works

SUPERVISES: Roadway Supervisors (3), Parks Supervisor (2), Construction

Supervisor (1), Forestry Supervisor (1), Shift Supervisors (4),

Manager of Operations

RESPONSIBLE FOR:

1. Develop and execute programs, policies, procedures, levels of service, and key performance indicators (KPI's) for annual operational maintenance programs.

- 2. Plan, lead and monitor the operations of the Section including but not limited to Winter Control (O.Reg. 239/02), ensuring operations are in compliance with provincial legislative requirements. Participate in Provincial Salt Management Plan.
- 3. Prepare, review and analyze technical reports, implementation of new methodologies and long-term operational planning of goals and objectives for the section. Ensure operations are in compliance with provincial legislative requirements.
- 4. Participate and regularly act as spokesperson in discussions/presentations/discoveries on issues to Council, agencies, the public, media and risk management. Attend various Committee/Council and public meetings as required.
- 5. Prepare council reports and presentations including recommendations for City Council consideration.
- 6. Prepare the operating and capital budgets for the Roadways, Construction, Parks and Forestry sections and monitor and control expenditures.
- 7. Provide both direct and indirect supervision. Set up standards of performance, monitor capital, financial and human resources, coordinate operations, provide guidance and leadership to team members to foster departmental growth.
- 8. Lead and participate in recruitment of staff, including the annual seasonal staff recruitment drive.

- 9. Respond to requests/inquiries/complaints from public or external agencies on issues related to matters pertaining to the Section. Manage contentious issues and provide information to senior staff and Council on the same.
- 10. Lead the associated Section in the modernization and continual improvement of programs, processes, workflow, computerized maintenance management systems, equipment, and service delivery.
- 11. Perform other related duties as required.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum requirement is a College diploma in Engineering or a related field, or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Designation as a Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T.) is desirable.
- Certificate in a Management Training Program at the Post-Secondary level considered an asset.
- At least seven (7) years related experience managing within a unionized environment with a multidisciplinary work force.
- Excellent knowledge of best practices for maintenance practices applicable to the Section.
- Thorough knowledge and understanding of statutes, regulations, and by-laws affecting the Section.
- Working knowledge of computer software applications.
