Site 13 Deerfield Park General	This park contains a provincially significant wetland consisting of a
Description	pond and numerous vernal pools. A swale drains water towards a storm sewer in the southwest corner of the park.
	There is a small amount of garbage and indications of past logging; otherwise there are few signs of human disturbance. Some construction debris from housing development has been dumped as well.
Polygon 1	Garlic mustard is present but not currently in large quantities. Many of the Ash trees seem to be dying out.
Recommendations	<ol> <li>There is a heavy invasion by Phragmites in the southeast corner of the park and along edges of the pond, moving gradually along swale into vernal pools. This should be removed, along with other invasive species.</li> <li>To raise awareness of the woodland features and functions, informative signage should be put on site. The signage should be installed near a main trail or access point to the woodland.</li> <li>Litter and debris should be removed from the woodland. Consideration should be made for the installation of waste receptacles at the entrance to the woodland in a convenient location for both the public and maintenance staff. Natural debris from dead trees shall be left on-site but moved off trails.</li> <li>A trail system shall be established to minimize existing and potential impacts from public use. The trail system shall be installed in appropriate (less sensitive) natural areas and allow for public enjoyment.</li> </ol>
