- **DESCRIPTION**: The surface treatment of various road segments throughout the City of Niagara Falls. On roads where an existing surface treatment layer exists, the work generally consists of the placement and compaction of recycled asphalt pavement (RAP) followed by the application of a single layer of surface treatment. On existing gravel or unpaved roads, the work generally consists of grading and leveling the surface of the roadway and the application of a double surface treatment layer. The surface treatment of gravel roads also helps to reduce maintenance costs by eliminating the need for regular maintenance activities including grading, re-shaping and the placement of dust suppressant.


ASPHALT OVERLAY PHASE 1

DESCRIPTION: Asphalt overlay on Maple St, First Ave, Baldwin Ave, Mulhern St, McLeod Rd, North St and Forsythe St. Phase 1 of the Asphalt Overlay Program is utilized to provide the placement of the surface course asphalt on previously completed capital projects that have concluded their one-year maintenance period. This program evaluates sections based on structural condition (shape), ride (smoothness), and surface distress (cracking and potholes). The work involved filling-in curb sections at catch basins, adjusting appurtenance to finished grade and the supply and placement of hot mix surface course asphalt.

- DESCRIPTION: Detailed design of the Beaverdams Road storm sewer and neighbourhood stormwater management pond. The stormwater management pond is proposed to be at the northwest corner of Beaverdams and Kalar Roads and will require the purchase of approximately 1.92 hectares of property. The pond and sewer works will provide the necessary outlet to allow for the separation of combined sewers within the Hodgson Subdivision area which will in turn reduce the risk of basement flooding and overflows to the environment

- **DESCRIPTION**: Detailed design of bridge replacement. Beck Road Bridge, approximately 32 meters long and 7 meters wide was constructed in 1952 and spans Lyons Creek; it is located approximately 180 meters south of Lyons Creek Road. The existing two lane, three span concrete rigid frame structure is in poor condition and its current use is restricted by a 12 tonne load posting. The new structure will be designed as per the Canadian Bridge Design code and will have a minimum life span of 75 years.

- **DESCRIPTION**: Fort Erie finalizing engineers report with anticipated invoice for 2016. The Town of Fort Erie in accordance with a resolution passed in By-law No. 95-2002 has retained a Drainage Engineer to prepare an Engineer's Report pursuant to section 76 of the Drainage Act. The primary objective of this report was to prepare a new schedule of assessments for future maintenance of the Black Creek Drainage works. As there is properties in the Black Creek Drain watershed within the Municipal boundaries of the City of Niagara Falls staff have played a supporting role to the Town of Fort Erie as they navigate through the Drainage Act process. Maintenance work on the Drain is anticipated to start spring of 2018.



- **DESCRIPTION**: Road conditions at Fairview and Lundy's Lane Cemeteries have been deteriorating for years while only using an interim approach for repairs. In an effort to proactively eliminate road related safety hazards, it is proposed that the City implement a five year plan, beginning in 2016, to identify, repair and/or replace the most hazardous areas.

DESCRIPTION: Cemetery Services and Parks Maintenance utilize a compound area adjacent to the Fairview Garage Facility to store seasonal machines (i.e. kubotas, tractors, trailers and plows, as well as materials including, but not limited to; park/cemetery benches, park/trail/cemetery hoop signs, bollards, and landscaping materials). The area is presently surrounded by old and dilapidated chain link fence and the surface is gravel. The area is regularly overgrown by seasonal grape vine, poison ivy and weeds. By paving the surface and installing a new security/privacy fence, the area will provide more secure and improved storage facilities for Parks, Trails and Cemeteries.

DESCRIPTION: Rehabilitation of the single span steel multi-plate arch culvert structure crossing under the Chippawa Parkway approximately 650 m west of Stanley Avenue. The culvert conveys flows from an existing watercourse to the Welland River. The gabion basket headwall, constructed circa 1970, has been rotating away from the roadway resulting in reduced lateral support. It will be replaced with a reinforced retaining wall.





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

DESCRIPTION: Removal, restoration and replanting of Ash trees impacted by the Emerald Ash Borer. The Emerald Ash Borer is an invading beetle that has killed millions of Ash trees in southern Ontario and the Great Lakes States. It attacks both healthy and stressed Ash trees when its larvae tunnel through the tree's vascular system which delivers water and nutrients through the tree. Once infected the mortality of Ash trees is nearly 100%, and the tree will die within 1 to 4 years of infestation. Infected trees on City boulevards could become dangerous and must be removed for public safety. It will take several years for the City's Forestry Crew to remove all the impacted trees city-wide.

- **DESCRIPTION**: Fairview facilities are incredibly out of date. In 2015, improvements commenced to improve the accessibility and security of the front entrance and the administrative area. Cemetery and Operations staff presently utilize washroom and lunchroom facilities that have not been updated in over thirty years. Proposed updated will include the development of an updated washroom with an attached locker room (currently part of the lunchroom). It will also see the improvement to the existing lunchroom to include improved cleanliness (i.e. separate locker room), lighting, ventilation (i.e. HVAC), and the provision of a basic kitchen.

Proposed replacement beginning in 2016 includes Fairview Cemetery sections on Stanley Avenue and Morrison Street, required fence at Lundy's United, and the old post and wire fences at Willoughby and Dell Cemeteries.
