Eligibility:

- The contest is open to all students currently enrolled in a Niagara Falls High School OR Niagara Falls residents in Grades 9-12 enrolled in school outside of Niagara Falls.
- Participation in the contest constitutes full and unconditional acceptance of and agreement to be bound by these contest rules by the student(s) and the legal guardian(s) of the student(s).

Sign up for MYAC's Film Contest! Student filmmakers are empowered to create a short film in any genre with the chance to have it shown off at MYAC's June Movie Night!

# Contest Rules:

All content must be:

- Minimum 5 minutes, maximum 15 minutes long
- Any genre is permissible
- Original creation reproducing, modifying, enhancing or altering a third party's preexisting work does not qualify as an original creation
- Created by currently enrolled high school students in grades 9-12
- Appropriate for a school/family setting (rated G, PG, or PG13)
- Standard MP4 format is preferred but not required
- No AI generated content will be accepted
- Films should include credits noting the contributions of all involved

## Submission Guidelines:

Submissions will be accepted from May 9, 2025, until June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 11:59pm.

Submissions are done in two parts and will not be accepted unless both are complete:

Determination of Winner:

• The winning entry will be selected by vote by the NFMYAC Youth Empowerment Subcommittee. Their decision will be final with no right of appeal.

- MYAC members are able to participate in contests so long as they are removed from the judging process.
- Contestants are permitted to work in groups, however, only one prize will be awarded per group should a group entry be chosen as a winner.
- The contest winner(s) will be notified via email and announced on NFMYAC Instagram in June.
- The odds of winning are dependent on the number of entries received.
- In the case that no suitable submission is received, the MYAC judging committee (Youth Empowerment) reserves the right to not select a winner.

# Prize:

1st Place - \$100 Best Buy Gift Card & Film played at MYAC's June Movie Night 2nd Place - \$50 Best Buy Gift Card & Film played at MYAC's June Movie Night

This prize remains the same regardless of the size of the team submitting the winning entry.
