

Tree Inventory

Refer to Table 1 of the report dated 6 December 2024. Trees measuring 10cm DBH and greater on and within six metres of the subject site and trees of all sizes within the road right-of-way were included in the inventory.

The preservation of the remaining three trees will be possible with the use of appropriate tree protection measures. Trees identified for preservation are indicated with GREEN labels. Tree protection measures must be implemented prior to the commencement of the proposed works. Required tree preservation fencing is indicated in MAGENTA. Refer to Tree Protection Plan Notes for preservation details.

Any roots or branches which extend beyond the TPZ indicated on this plan which require pruning, must be pruned by a qualified Arborist or other tree professional as approved by the City of Niagara Falls. All pruning of tree roots and branches must be in accordance with good arboricultural standards. Roots located outside the TPZ that have received approval from the City of Niagara Falls to be pruned must first be exposed by hand digging or by using a low pressure hydro vac method. This will allow a proper pruning cut and minimize tearing of the roots. The Arborist/tree professional retained to carry out crown or root pruning must contact the City of Niagara Falls no less than 48 hours prior to conducting any specified work.
