Pursuant to Section 53 of the Planning Act, the Committee of Adjustment for the City of Niagara Falls invites you to participate in a public hearing to consider an application for consent (severance) and Partial Discharge of Mortgage and/or to forward written comments prior to the hearing. Written comments are the preferred method of receiving public input and may be sent by mail or email. You can also provide oral input by joining the hearing.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to find out more about this application and offer comments. The public meeting is scheduled to take place on Tuesday April 25, 2023 at 4:00 pm in Committee Room 2 at City Hall for the Committee of Adjustment to consider this application.

Applicant: Giovana Butera

Location: The subject lands are known municipally as 7960 Oakwood Drive, located on the east side of Oakwood Drive, south of McLeod Road.

Proposal: The applicant is proposing to convey Parts 4 and 5 to be added to Part 3 and 10, subject to a Right of way over part 10 together with an easement over Parts 7, 8, 14, 15, 16 and 18 and a partial discharge of mortgage. Parts 1 and 2 will be dedicated to the City of Niagara Falls for a future road widening.

The subject property known as 7960 Oakwood Drive is zoned Prestige Industrial (PI), in accordance with By-law No. 79-200, as amended by Committee of Adjustment application A-2017-049.




