Public input on applications is invited. Pursuant to Section 53 of the Planning Act, the Committee of Adjustment for the City of Niagara Falls invites you to participate in a remote public hearing to consider an application for consent (severance) and/or to forward written comments prior to the hearing. During this time, written comments are the preferred method of receiving public input. Written comments may be sent by mail or email. You can also provide oral input by joining the hearing (electronic or in-person).

To participate remotely in the public hearing and to provide input orally, please pre-register with the Secretary-Treasurer by sending an email to eroupas@niagarafalls.ca or calling 905-356-7521 (Ext. 4239) before 12 noon on October 17th. All registrants will be provided with instructions on how to use their computer, tablet or phone to participate remotely in the public hearing.



Location: The subject property known as 8178 Thorold Stone Road located on the south side of Thorold Stone Road between Kalar Road

Proposal: An application has been made for a partial discharge of mortgage and to sever a parcel of land (Part 2) with an area of 500.5 square metres for the construction of a future detached dwelling. A parcel of land (Part 1) with an area of 907.5 square metres will be retained for continued residential use known municipally as 8178 Thorold Stone Road.

A concurrent Zoning By-law Amendment application (AM-2023-012) has been submitted for this property to facilitate the creation of the proposed lot (Part 2) and the construction of a detached dwelling.
