Pursuant to Section 45 of the Planning Act, the Committee of Adjustment for the City of Niagara Falls invites you to participate in a public hearing to consider an application for minor variances and/or to forward written comments prior to the hearing. Written comments are the preferred method of receiving public input and may be sent by mail or email. You can also provide oral input by joining the hearing inperson or electronically.

All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to find out more about this application and offer comments. The public meeting is scheduled to take place on Tuesday November 28,2023 at 4:00 pm, in Committee Room 2 at City Hall for the Committee of Adjustment to consider this application.



Location: The subject property known as 5619 Stanley Avenue is located on the west side of Stanley Avenue between North Street and Emery Street.

The applicant is requesting the Committee of Adjustment to consider minor variances from provisions of Zoning By-law No 79-200, as amended, through a process permitted by Section 45(1) of the Planning Act (R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13).

Proposal: The applicant is proposing to construct a twostorey building containing a restaurant (KFC, Taco Bell) and an office on the subject property which currently contains a retail store and a 10 seat restaurant. The applicant is also proposing a separate structure for a car wash on the subject property. The subject property is zoned Tourist Commercial (TC) in accordance with Zoning By-law 79-200, as amended by By-law 2012-060. The TC zone regulations for a retail



store and restaurant, and section 8.6.4 (regulations for gasoline bars in accordance with section 8.9.3 in the AS zone) would apply for this proposal:

Car Wash waiting lane	4 parking spaces in line per bay	2 x 2 parking spaces in line per bay (4 in total)	2 parking spaces in line
Exterior side yard width	12.0 metres & 15.25 metres from centreline of Stanley Avenue	8.75 metres & 15.25 metres from centreline of Stanley Avenue	3.25 metres

If a specified person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Committee of Adjustment for the City of Niagara Falls in respect of the proposed minor variance does not make written submissions to the Committee before it gives or refuses approval, the Ontario Land Tribunal may dismiss the appeal.
