PROPOSED AMENDMENT

An application has been made to amend the Sign By-law to permit the installation on the existing canopy of:

- 2 illuminated readograph signs (to replace existing);
- 2 "Seneca Theatre" canopy signs above the canopy;
- 1 logo sign; and,
- Exterior illumination and illumination of graphic symbols.

The existing and requested regulations are outlined more specifically in the table in Schedule 1. The proposed site plan and signage is illustrated in Schedule 2.
