

**Location:** Parts 2 and 3 on Schedule 1, forming part of parcel 2725 110 00109 502 Portage Road, located south of 7657 Portage Road.

**Proposal:** At the February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 Committee of Adjustment meeting, the Committee of Adjustment approved consents, easements, partial discharge of mortgages, and minor variances at 7657 Portage Road and 2725 110 00100 285 Stanley Avenue. The following easements have now been requested to satisfy conditions of the approved consents:



- Part 2 easement for access in favour of Marineland of Canada Inc. in perpetuity.
- Part 3 easement/encroachment agreement for the building, and access and maintenance thereto in favour of Marineland of Canada Inc. for a period 50 years.

If the applicant, the minister, a specified person or public body as defined in the *Planning Act* has an interest in the matter may appeal the decision to the committee within 20 days of the making of the decision by filing a notice of appeal with the Secretary – Treasurer.
