IMPORTANT PARADE SET UP INFORMATION

Parade Set Up Time is at 9:00 am along Armoury and Jepson Streets

ALL VEHICLES & FLOATS MUST BE IN PLACE AT THIS TIME!

Please travel in from Valley Way to your location. Staff & Volunteers will be nearby to assist with directions. Armoury Street and Jepson Street will be closed in the set up area from 7:30 am

Niagara Transit will provide a Free Parade Shuttle for Parade Participants from 8:30 am – 10:00 am from the King Eddy Parking lot, beside City Hall to the Parade Staging Area. The King Eddy Parking Lot is located on Zimmerman at Queen Street.

The Parade will begin at 11:00 am sharp!

Parade Entries – Please Remember:

- Set Up time is at 9:00 a.m. on July 1 for ALL Vehicles and Floats
- Once the Parade begins, Remain 10 metres apart from the entry in front and back of you.
- No stopping to perform
- Stay in a forward motion only
- Please do not throw candy or any items from a moving vehicle.
- Decorate your entry in a Canada Day Theme! Music and Singing are encouraged!
- ALL Mascots MUST have at least One Handler & Walk on the sidelines of the Parade!
- Anyone walking with a vehicle or float must remain at least 5' away from moving vehicle
- Please review the Parade Rules
- Remember to send in your completed insurance form & copy of vehicle insurance!
- Join in the festivities on Queen Street after the Parade!

The Volunteer Check In, Information Office and St. John Ambulance First Aid Room will be located inside the City's BIZ Office located at 4321 Queen Street, across from City Hall.
