	Specification Requirements	Bidder to state yes or no
1	Cleaning, testing, inspection including moisture barrier integrity testing and all repairs as necessary must be per ISO 9001: 2000 certification, and NFPA 1851, 2020 Edition compliant and ITS (Intertek Testing Services) certification. Bidding Company must attach to their quotation submission copies of current compliancy certification to these standards.	
2	All repairs must be made with NFPA compliant materials consistent with the fabrics and materials in the specific garment (complete bunker gear set) and in accordance with NFPA 1851, 2020 Edition certification; NFPA 1971, 2018 Edition certification; CGSB 155.1 standard; ULC and the construction requirements of the OEM.	
3	Provide an Internet Website that the Niagara Falls Fire Department personnel can track status of inspections and repairs that have been completed. Bidders may be required to provide a live onsite demonstration of the Website for evaluation purposes by the Fire Department.	
4	Provide comprehensive, written documentation for all Inspections, cleaning, and repairs that are conducted. All documentation shall be compliant with NFPA 1851-2020 requirements.	
5	Provide pick-up and delivery service to Fire Station #1, 5815 Morrison Street. Such pick-up and delivery costs to be included in prices quoted.	
6	Provide costing details on Price Schedule (previous page) for minor repairs including rips, tears, burn holes, striping replacement, button or zipper replacement, sewing of seams etc.	
7	Bidders to provide on a separate sheet (supplied by the Bidder) company background information with related experience in supplying the services as specified herein, including number of years in business and current contact information for company officials with names and phone numbers	
8	Bidders to verify insurance coverage on the Price Schedule (previous page) for causes including loss of Bunker Gear Sets and damages of any kind to Bunker Gear Sets while in the possession of the successful bidder.	
9	Bidders to verify they are recognized and authorized by Innotex, and Morning Pride Manufacturing as authorized to inspect and repair Bunker Gears for these manufacturers.	
10	Bidders to state compliancy with all specifications and requirements stated in these quotation documents.
